Amesbury Industrial Database - up to 1930

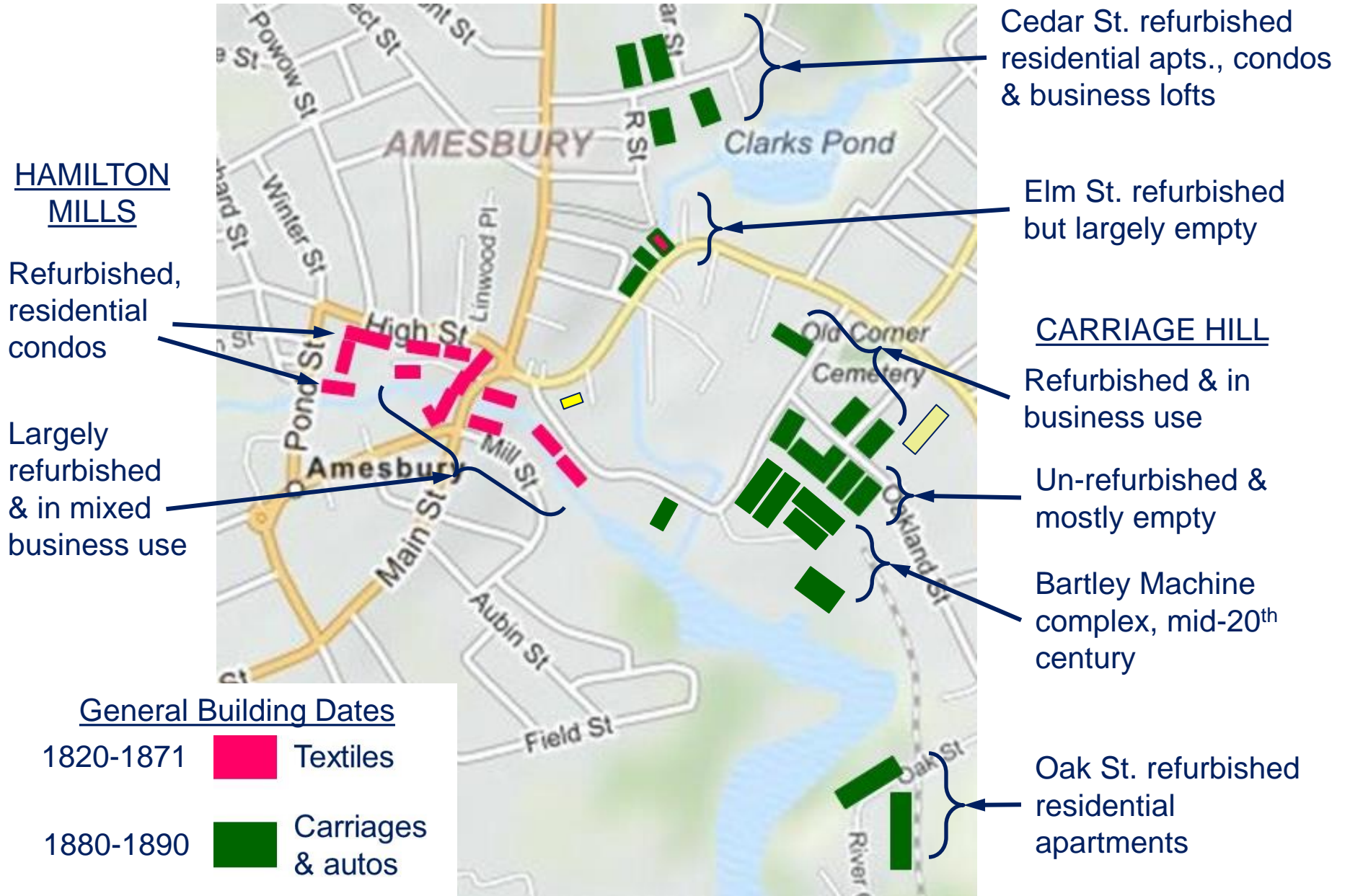
Maps and address tables presented here show what business entities were at what building addresses, in chronological order. It is complete up to 1930, with some later businesses included where data happened to be available. Street names are arranged alphabetically, and addresses in numerical order.

Red addresses on street maps generally conform to current street names and numbers. For most streets, current numbers are very close to their historical values. Quite a few addresses have been verified by the 1891 carriage industry directory, for which that column carries an X. Some street names have changed from their historical names.

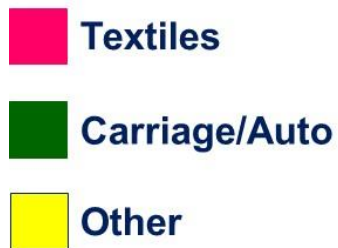
For Carriage Hill, the name Carriage Ave. is used up to the fire of 1888, then is called Oakland St. thereafter, even though the name was not changed until 1906. Chestnut A St. is pre-fire, Chestnut St. is post-fire

Maps progressions are included for areas of prolonged growth and change. While illustrative, they do not capture all the changes. Outlying areas were relatively more stable, until carriage industry decline wiped out the businesses and those locations rapidly became residential.

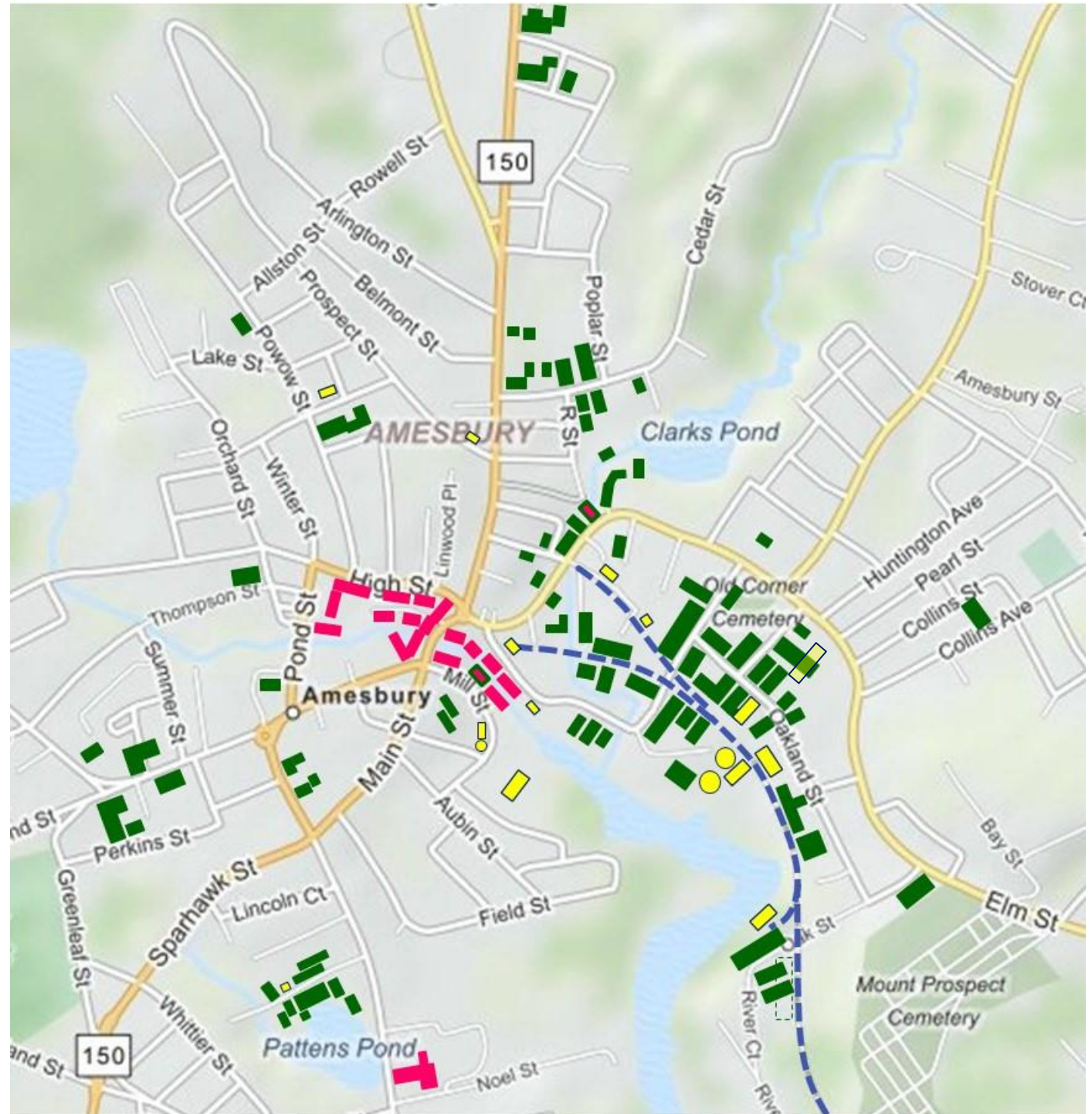
Existing Historical Industrial Buildings & Current Uses

These sites did not all exist simultaneously, but a large majority of them coexisted ca. 1890. That was the peak of carriage production, just prior to the economic crash of 1892-3.



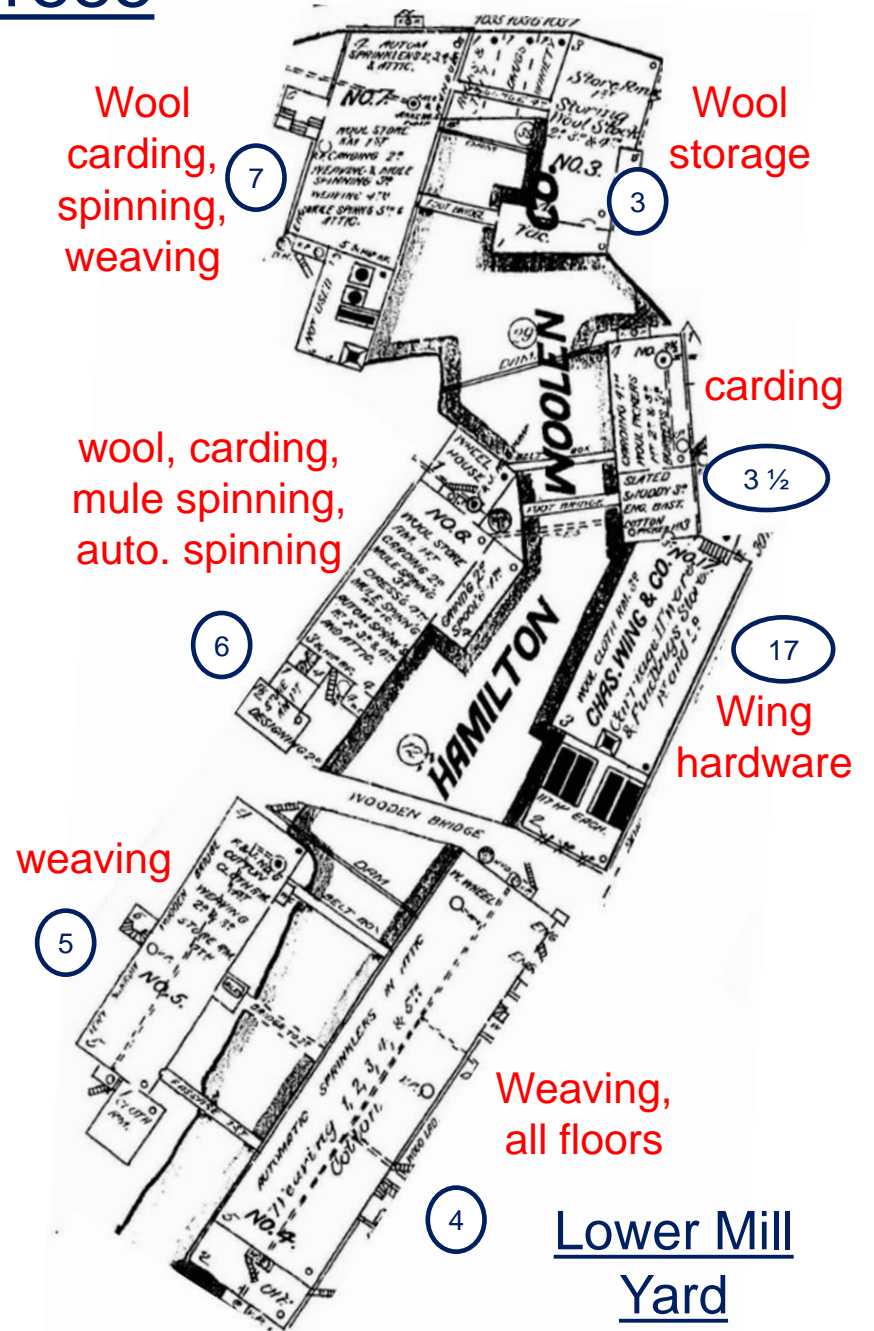
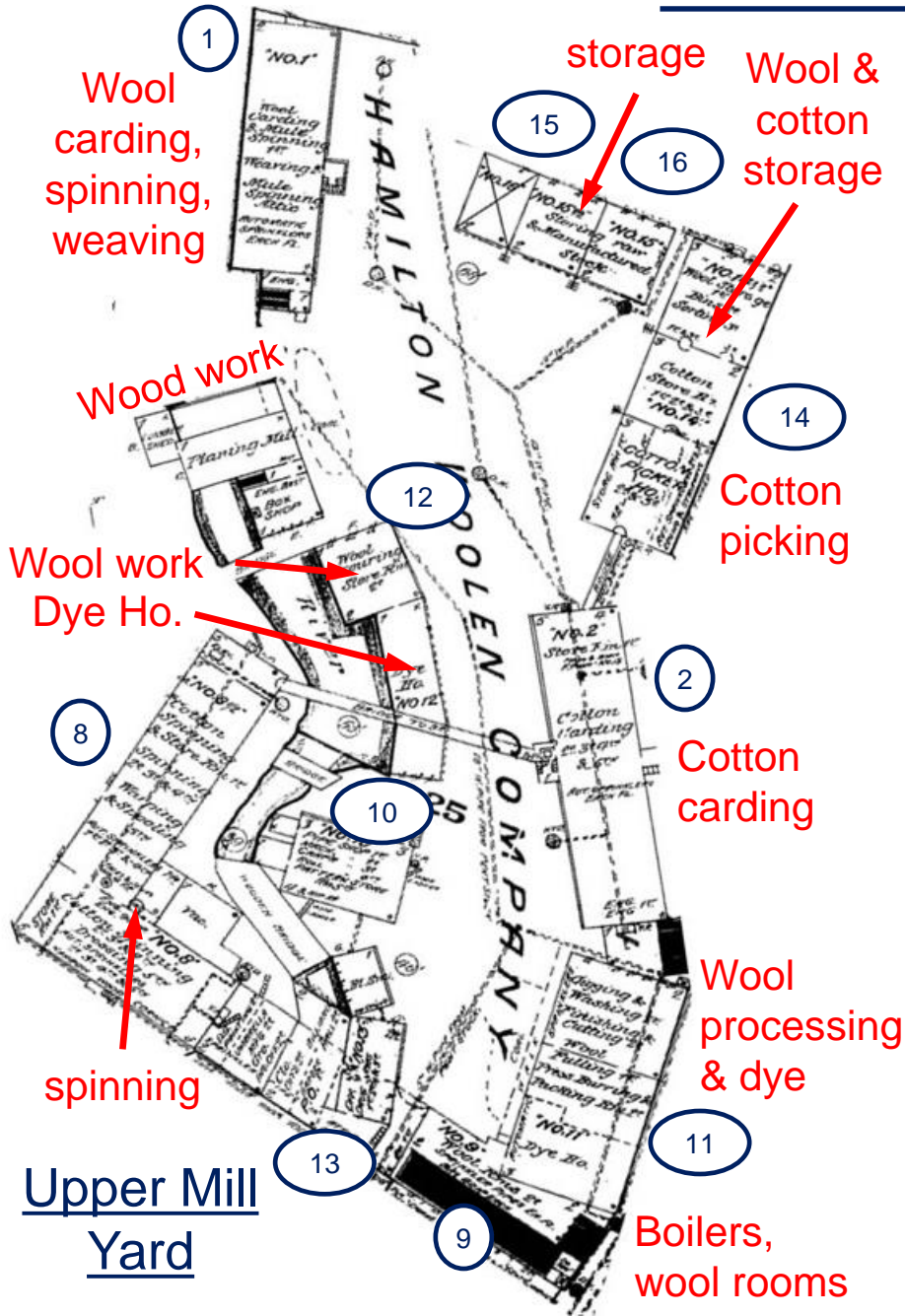
Gradual Dis-Use of the Textile Mill Buildings

Large brick buildings along the Powow River were originally built as textile mills, and operated as such until the last mill owner went out of business in 1914. They were originally water powered, and then added considerable steam power in 1871. They had sufficiently large power generating capacity that they were purchased in 1914 by a utility company.

Since their beginning, the mills had processed both cotton and wool, the two materials requiring some differences in machinery and its setups. Fortunes of the mills had been declining for decades, such that they discontinued wool work in 1887. It might be imagined that building space previously devoted to wool work would have then been converted to cotton processing. However, most of that space then went fallow, such that several buildings sat totally empty, while some other space was rented out to retail or other businesses.

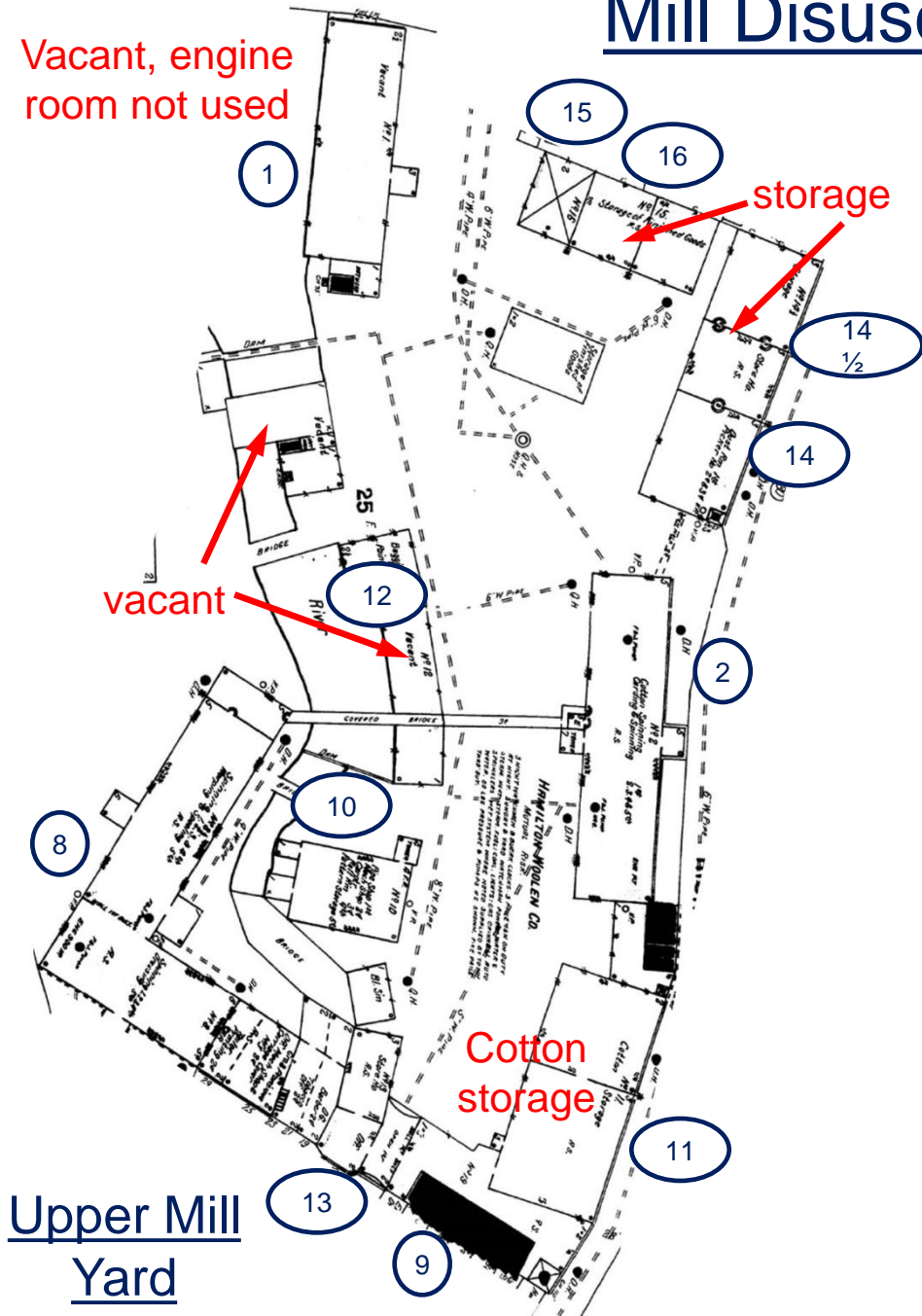
It is surprising that the mills survived as long as they did. The before and after comparison of building use is shown on the following two pages.

Mill Use - 1885



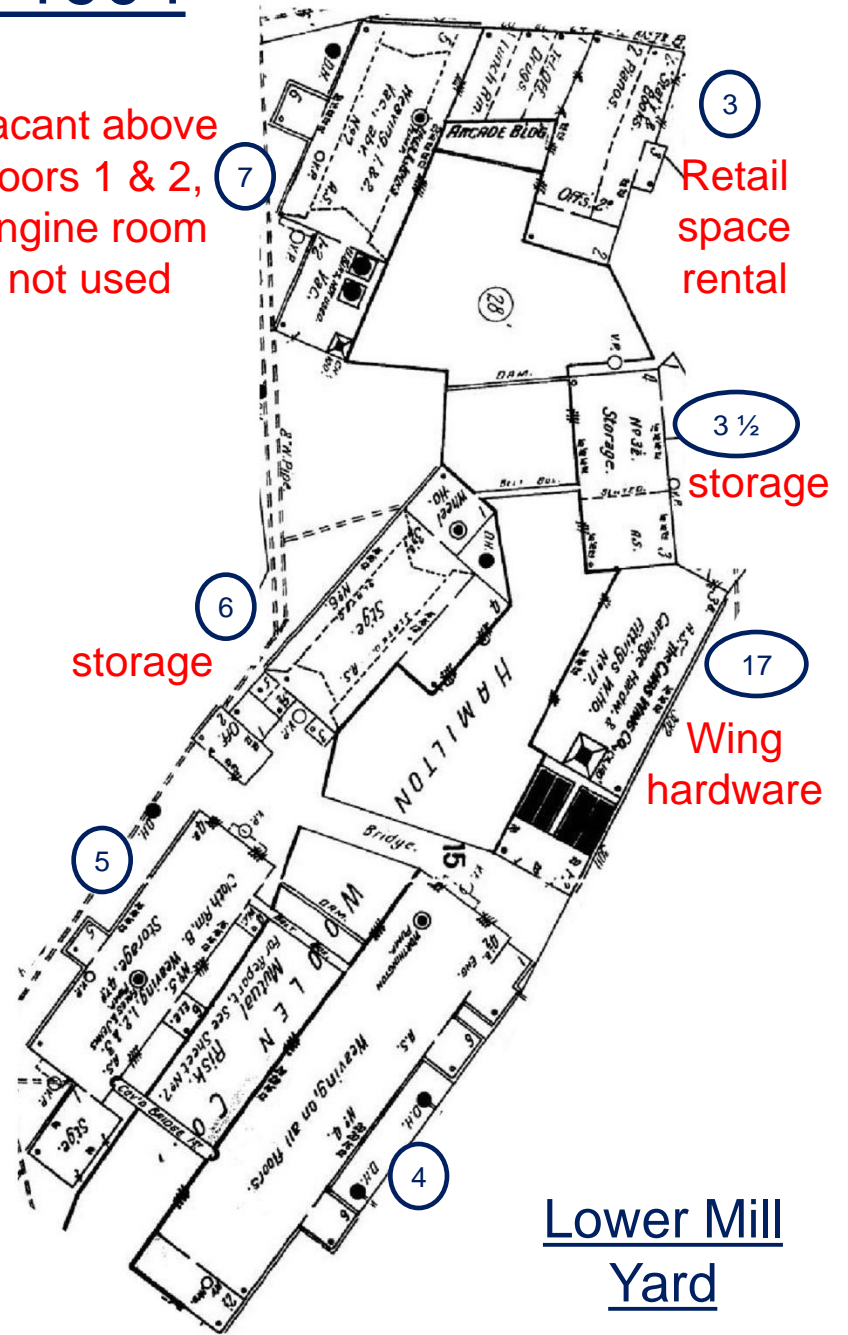
Mill Disuse - 1904

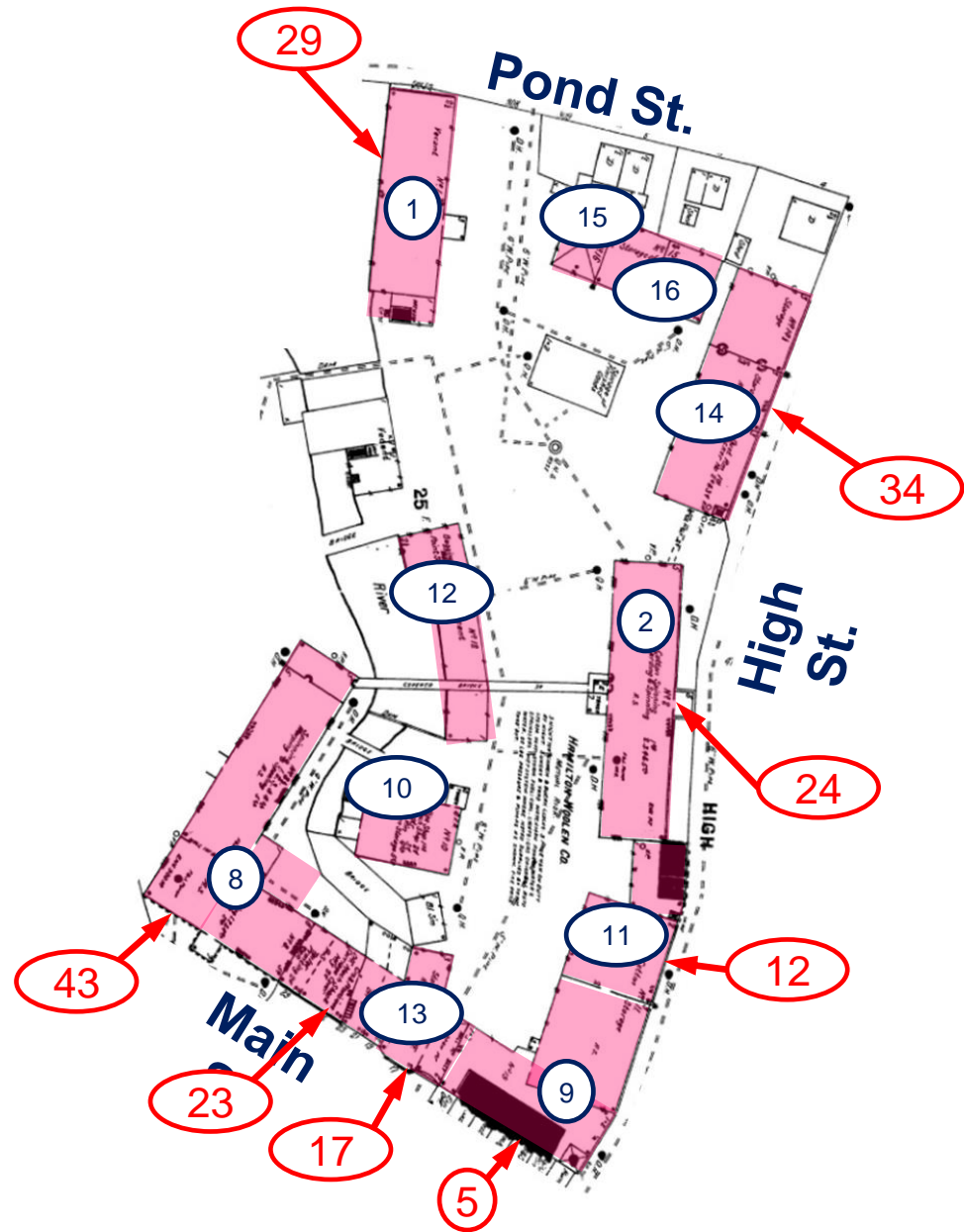
Vacant above floors 1 & 2, engine room not used

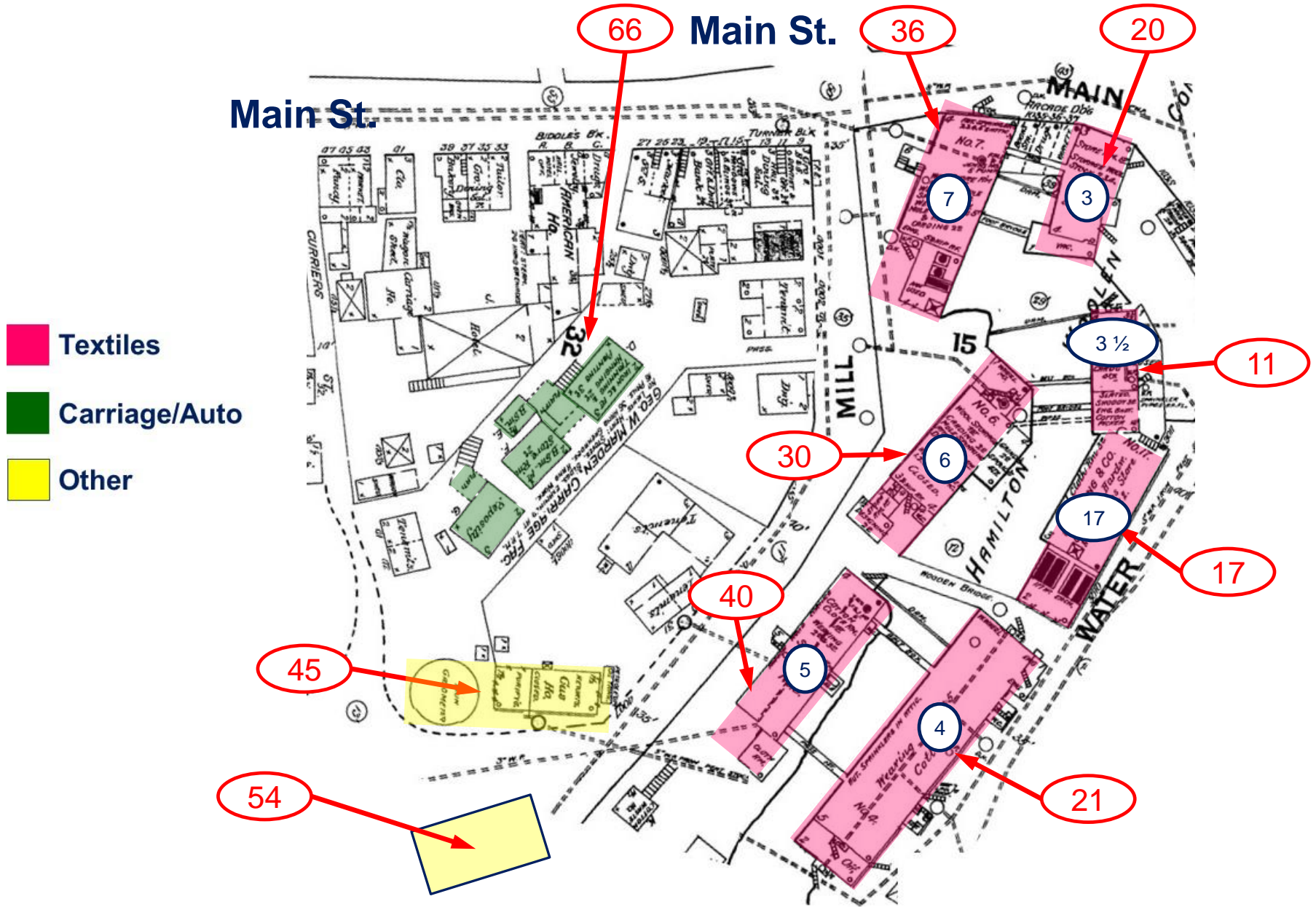

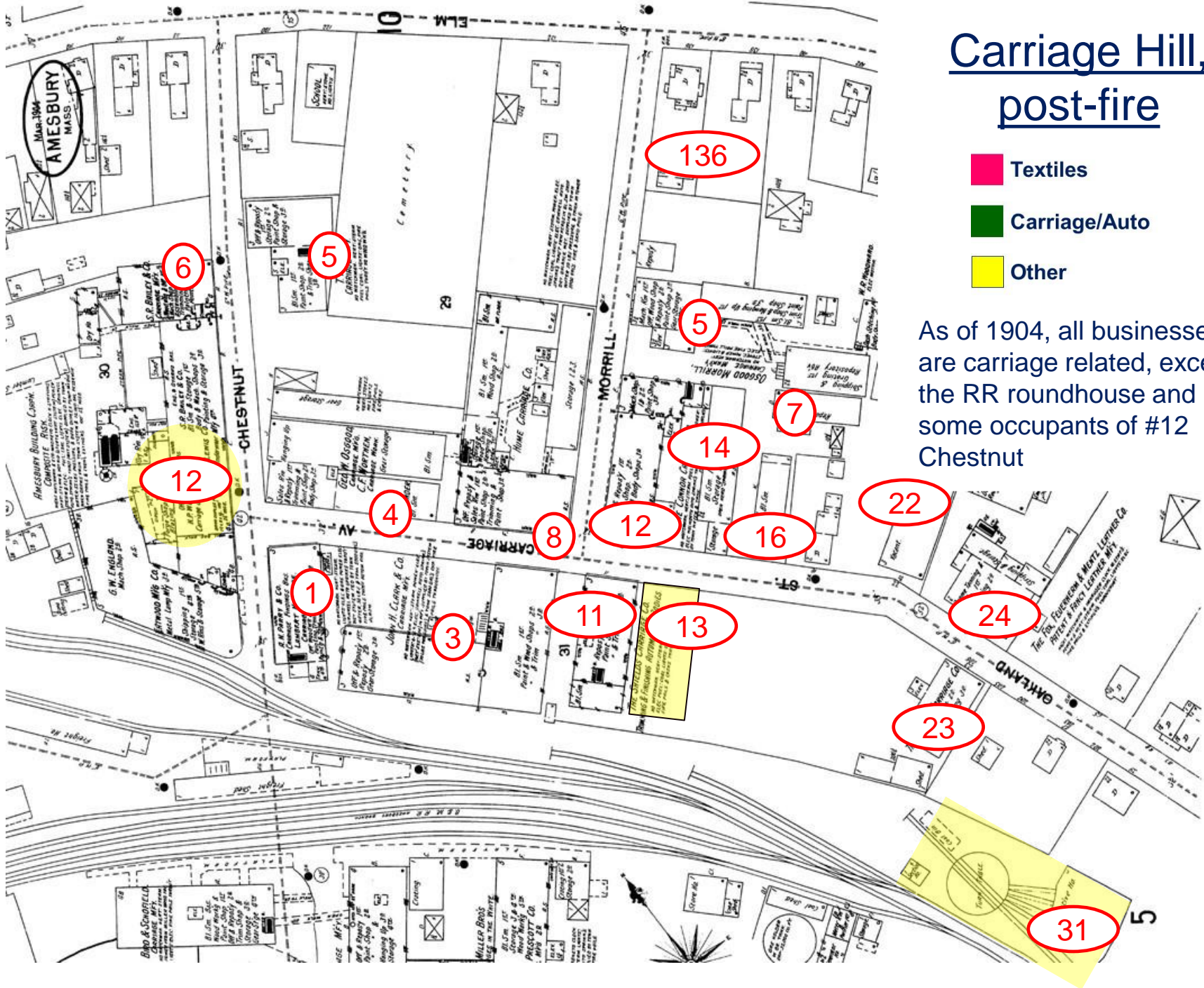

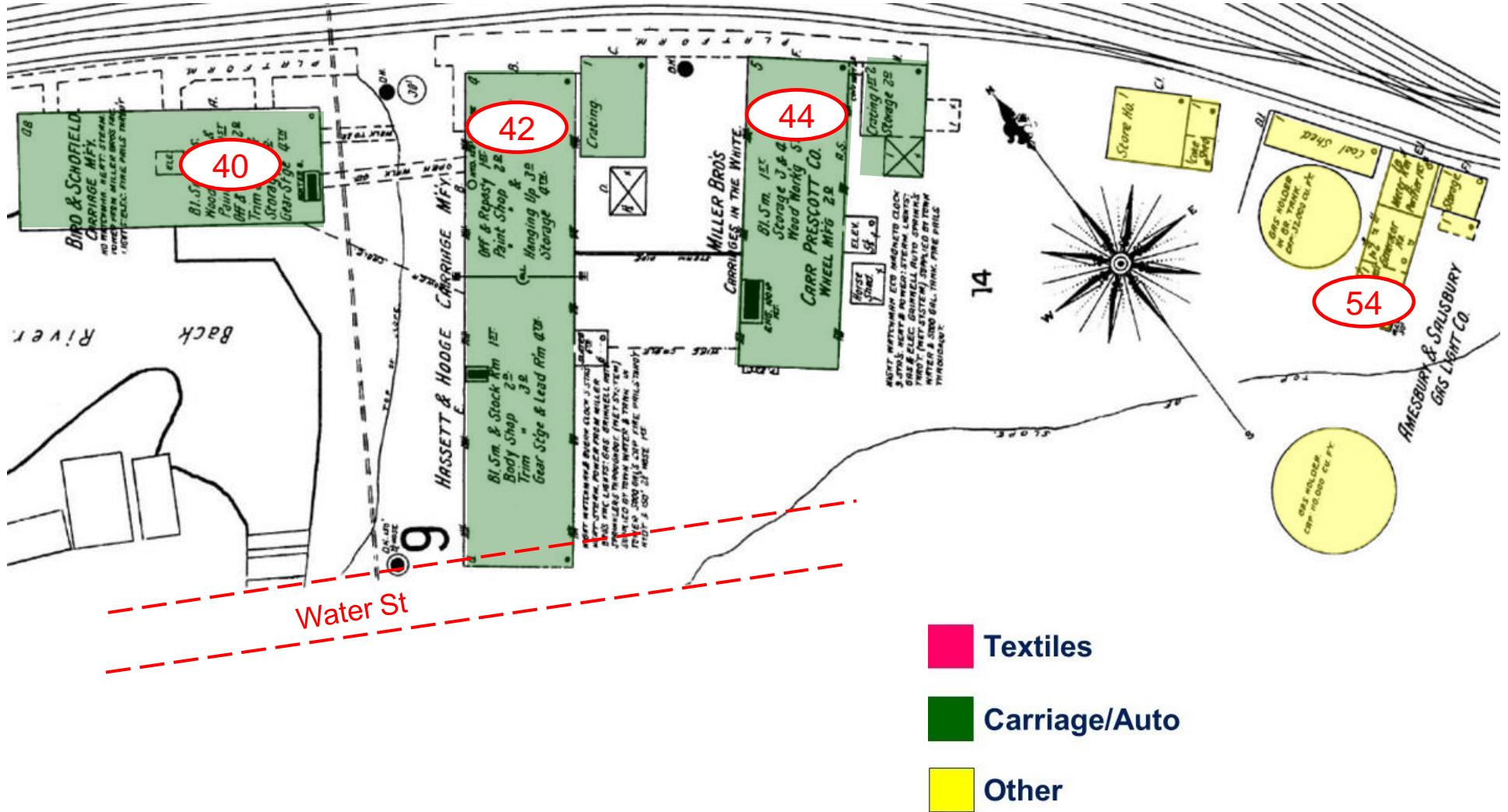

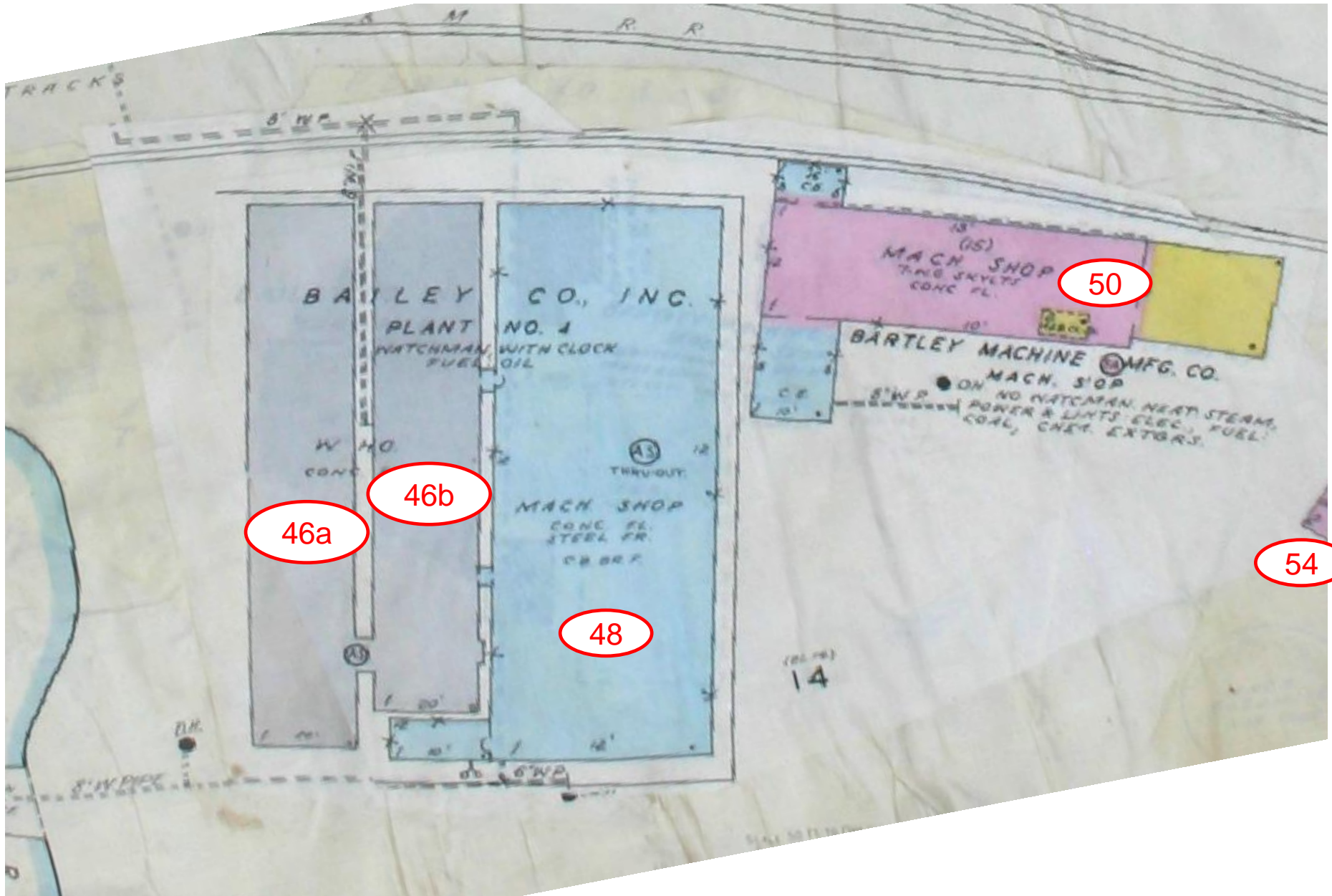
